MINT students are invited to obtain graduate credit for their Montessori training through The Institute for Educational Studies (TIES) at Endicott College, an internationally recognized Montessori graduate program. Endicott College is located in Beverly, Massachusetts, just north of Boston.

To earn your M.Ed. requires 36 credits that are predominantly covered in your training course. In addition to the program outlined by MINT, students will complete the following requirements for the graduate degree:

1. academic paper describing what was learned during the first summer at MINT
2. a similar paper after the second summer
3. ten day online seminar during the academic year between first and second summers
4. six week online seminar after your second summer to develop a research question for your practice teaching
5. three additional online courses, including a culminating project completed after you finish your Montessori certification

There are no required residencies on the physical campus.

The tuition for the above is \$1950 per semester for five semesters. Enrollment through Endicott College entitles students to apply for Federally Financed Student Loans. To obtain the M.Ed. students need to be jointly enrolled with MINT and Endicott from the beginning of the Montessori training course. (Note: If more than ten MINT students enroll there will be further tuition adjustments.)
